### Cryptorchid - Retained Testicle

Males that are cryptorchid are at increased risk of testicular cancer and should be neutered. Neutering a cryptorchid male typically has a longer anesthesia / surgical time and more surgical supplies used to perform the neuter procedure. **As a result there is an additional charge of \$\_\_\_\_\_.**

### Retained Baby Teeth

Retained baby teeth create crowding in the mouth accelerating the onset of dental plaque and tartar. It is highly recommended these teeth be removed to preserve the adult teeth. To have these baby teeth removed there is **an additional cost of \$10.00/tooth**
