Procedure to Perform: Ovariohysterectomy (Spay)

Pre-Surgical Bloodwork

Pre-surgical bloodwork is an in-house chemistry panel that does an examination of your pet's liver and kidney function to help determine if your pet is able to handle general anesthesia today. Any abnormalities will be brought to your attention and the proper course of action taken. By checking "No" you decline the pre-surgical bloodwork for your pet. By checking "Yes" you give Hickory Small Animal permission to perform the pre-surgical bloodwork at an **additional cost of \$42.50**

Pain Medication

After most surgical procedures, your pet will experience some pain. Hickory Small Animal Hospital offers post surgical pain medications to limit this discomfort and allow your pet to rest comfortably. We can give your pet a pain injection before surgery **for an additional \$13.00**.

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In Heat

Females that are beginning, going through or recovering from an estrous cycle ("In Heat"), have increased vasculature and typically have a longer anesthesia / surgical time and more surgical supplies used to perform the spay procedure. **As a result there is an additional charge of \$_____.**

Pregnant

Pregnant female pets have larger vasculature feeding their uterine horns and uterine body and typically have a longer anesthesia / surgical time and more surgical supplies used to perform the spay procedure. **As a result there is an additional charge of \$_____.**

Retained Baby Teeth

Retained baby teeth create crowding in the mouth accelerating the onset of dental plaque and tartar. It is highly recommended these teeth be removed to preserve the adult teeth. To have these baby teeth removed there is **an additional cost of \$10.00/tooth**
